

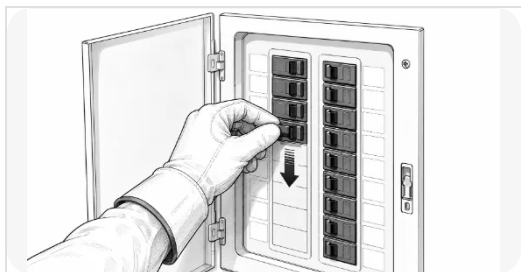
BEFORE YOU BEGIN

WARNING · Make sure power is **OFF** at the breaker before starting installation or any maintenance.

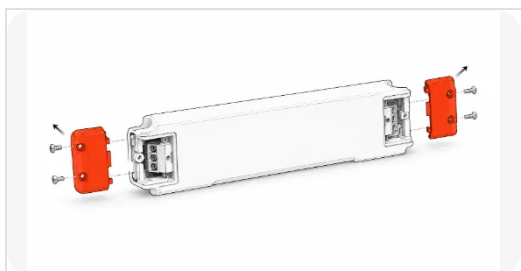
SAFETY · This driver must be wired in accordance with local electrical codes and ordinances. All work should be done by a qualified electrician.

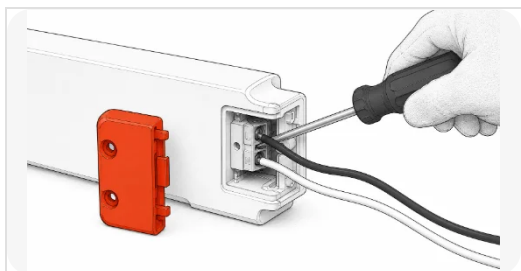
INSTALLATION



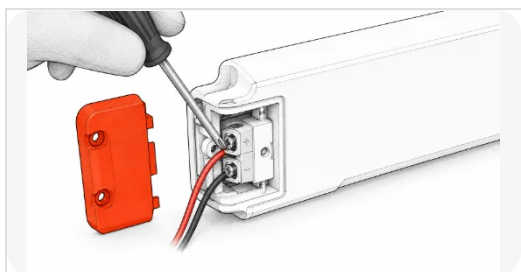
01 Turn off power at the breaker.



02 Remove the terminal covers on the driver.

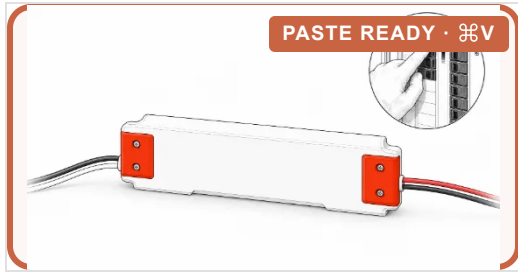


03 Connect **Black** to **Hot** and **White** to **Neutral** on the high-voltage side.



04 Connect **+** to the positive wire and **-** to the negative wire on the low-voltage side.

INSTALLATION (CONTINUED)



01 Restore the covers and energize.

□ Neutral	WHITE
■ Positive (+)	LOW VOLT
■ Negative (-)	LOW VOLT
